Presidential Preference Primary
April 7, 2020

At the Spring Election and Presidential Preference Primary to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, in the Town of Spring Brook, electors of Wards 1 and 2 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810th Street; Elk Mound, WI). All polling places will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. This polling place is accessible to elderly and disabled voters. Voter registration is required. Photo identification is required. Voting selections include Presidential Preference, Judicial, County, School District, and Referendum questions. Sample ballots are posted at the Town Hall and are available online at MyVote.wi.gov. If you have any questions concerning your polling place, contact Municipal Clerk Mary L. Strand at 715-664-8545 (Town Hall Office). At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors at this polling place will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89. If necessary, the Town of Spring Brook Municipal Board of Canvassers shall meet on Friday, April 10, 2020, at 4 p.m. at the Spring Brook Town Hall to process and document any provisional ballots.
