Partisan Office and Referendum Election
November 3, 2020

At the Partisan Office and Referendum Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, in the Town of Spring Brook, electors of Wards 1 and 2 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810th Street; Elk Mound, WI). All polling places will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. This polling place is accessible to elderly and disabled voters. Voter registration is required. Photo identification is required. Voting selections include President and Vice President; Representative in Congress District 3; Representative to the Assembly District 67; District Attorney; County Clerk; County Treasurer; Register of Deeds; Referendum Question 1 regarding legislative and congressional district plans and maps; and Referendum Question 2 regarding Dunn County exceeding the county levy for the next five fiscal years by up to \$1,000,000 per year for the Dunn County Hazardous Waste Collection (Clean Sweep) Program and capital expenditures of the Dunn County Solid Waste and Recycling Program. Sample ballots are posted at the Town Hall and are available online at MyVote.wi.gov. If you have any questions concerning your polling place, contact Municipal Clerk Mary L. Strand at 715-664-8545 (Town Hall Office). At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors at this polling place will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
