

TOWN OF SPRING BROOK
Partisan Primary Election
August 9, 2022

At the Partisan Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, August 9, 2022, in the Town of Spring Brook of Dunn County, electors of Wards 1, 2, and 3 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810th Street; [rural] Elk Mound, WI). All polling places will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. All polling places are accessible to elderly and voters with disabilities. Voter registration is required. Photo identification is required. In the Partisan Primary, voters may vote in only ONE party's primary on the ballot. Offices on the ballot include statewide, congressional, legislative, and county contests. Sample ballots are posted at the Town Hall and on the Dunn County Clerk's website (<https://www.co.dunn.wi.us/countyclerk>), plus ballot information is available online at MyVote.wi.gov. If you have any questions concerning your polling place, contact the municipal clerk.

At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant Wis. Stat. § 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
