REFERENDUM ELECTION NOTICE  
November 8, 2022**

At the Partisan Office and Referendum Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, in the Town of Spring Brook of Dunn County, electors of Wards 1, 2, and 3 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810<sup>th</sup> Street; [rural] Elk Mound, WI). All polling places will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. All polling places are accessible to elderly and voters with disabilities. Voter registration is required. Photo identification is required. Offices on the ballot include Statewide, Congressional, Legislative, and County offices plus a Dunn County referendum question and an Eau Claire Area School District referendum question. Sample ballots are posted on the Town Hall outside posting board and are available online at **MyVote.wi.gov**. If you have any questions concerning your polling place, contact the municipal clerk.

At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant Wis. Stat. § 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
