SPRING ELECTION *REVISED NOTICE
APRIL 2, 2024**

At the Presidential Preference, State Referendum, and Spring Election to be held on April 2, 2024, in the Town of Spring Brook, Dunn County, Wisconsin, the electors within Wards 1-3 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810th Street; [rural] Elk Mound, WI) for the Presidential Preference Vote; County Supervisor, School Board, and two State Referendum questions. Sample ballots are posted *inside the Town Hall and are available online at **MyVote.wi.gov**. The Town Hall is accessible to all voters, including elderly and disabled voters. Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Voter registration is required. Photo identification is required. At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
