Partisan Primary and  
Referenda Election Notice  
August 13, 2024**

At the Partisan Primary and Referenda Election to be held on August 13, 2024, in the Town of Spring Brook, Dunn County, Wisconsin, the electors within Wards 1-3 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810<sup>th</sup> Street; [rural] Elk Mound, WI) for Congressional, Legislative and State, and County positions plus two State Referenda questions. Sample ballots are posted inside the Town Hall and outside on the posting board and are available online at **MyVote.wi.gov**. The Town Hall is accessible to all voters, including elderly and disabled voters. Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Voter registration is required. Photo identification is required. At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvass pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.
